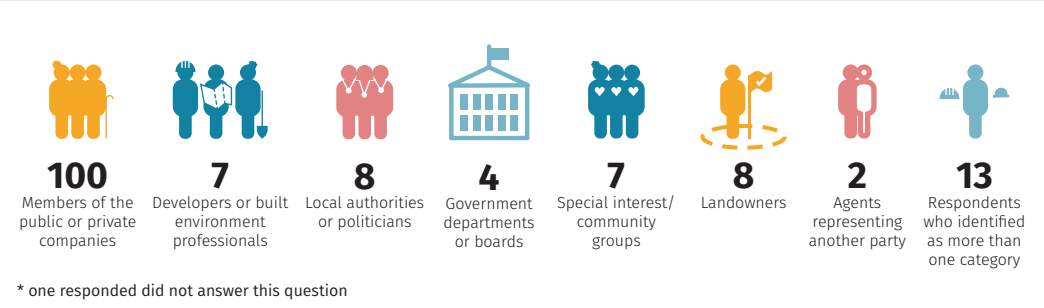
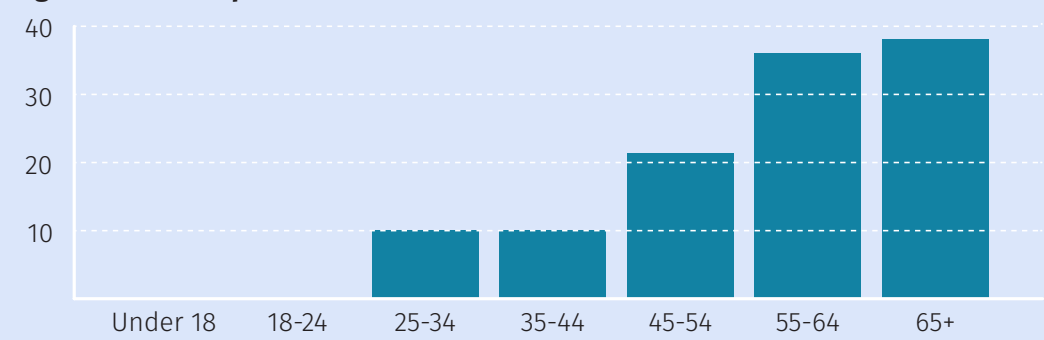

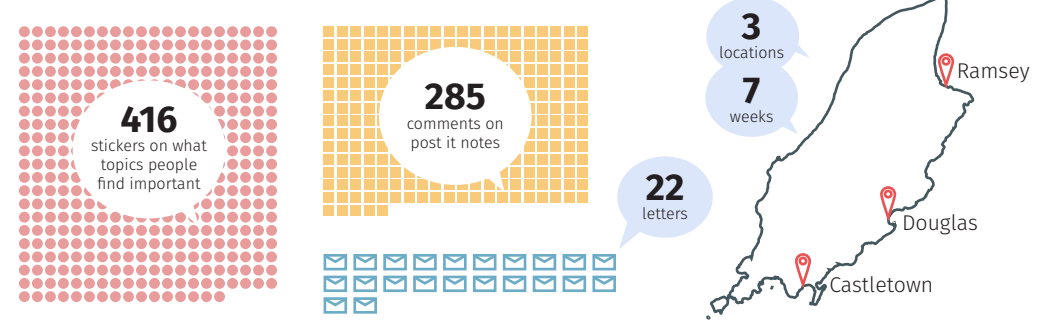
Public consultation and interactive exhibition response summary infographic

Paper 2: The pattern and distribution of development



73% of respondents agreed that future development must align **with infrastructure capacity**, while 20% were neutral and 6% expressed no concern

Paper 3: Urban communities and centres

73% of respondents consider it important to include policies that **protect built heritage** and integrate it into new schemes, while 20% were neutral and 7% viewed it as unimportant



Paper 4: Rural communities and the countryside



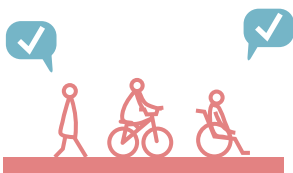
52% of respondents support a more restricted use of the rural exception rule **to retain examples of Manx vernacular architecture**, while 30% were neutral and 18% opposed

74% of respondents do not support including a **rural exception rule for renewable energy** projects, while 19% support it and 7% were neutral

49% of respondents agree there should be a specific **policy for active travel connections**, while 25% disagree and 26% were neutral
