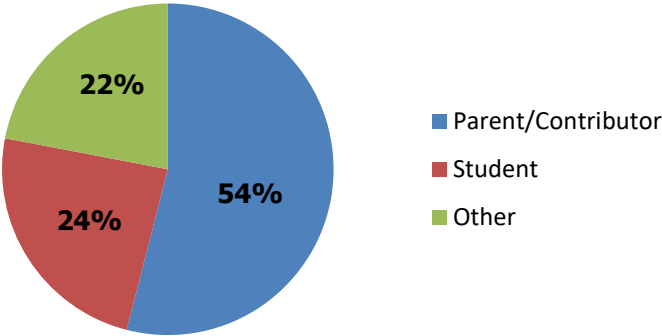
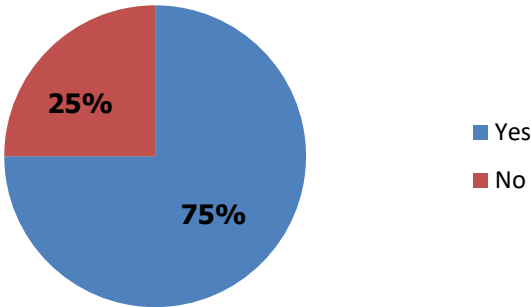

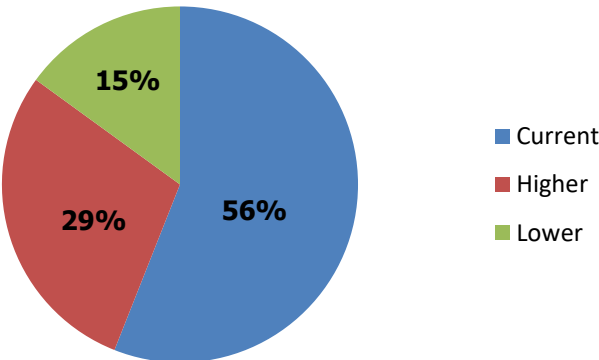

Maintenance Grants for on-Island Study



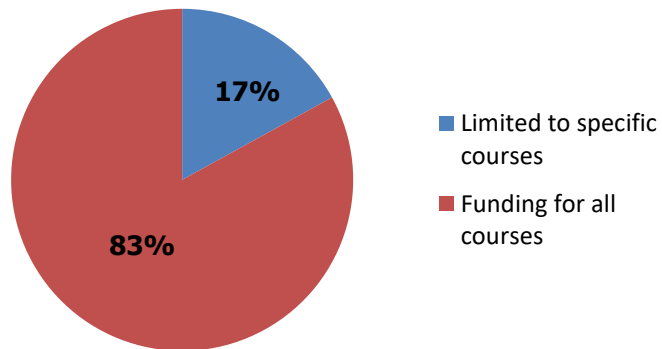
Q4. What should the level of funding for on-Island study be?

Level of funding for on-Island study



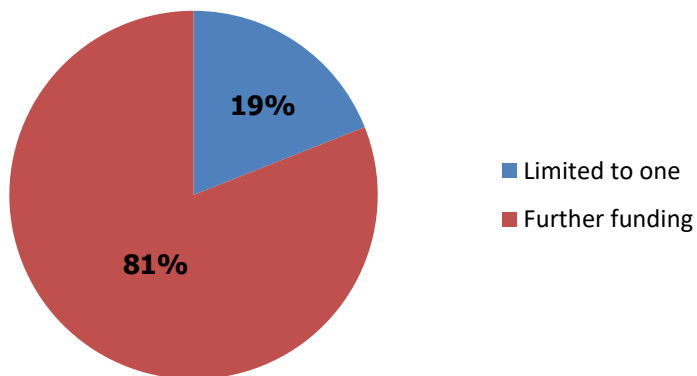
Q5. Should funding for courses be limited to specific subjects to meet Isle of Man skills shortages and aid local economic recovery?

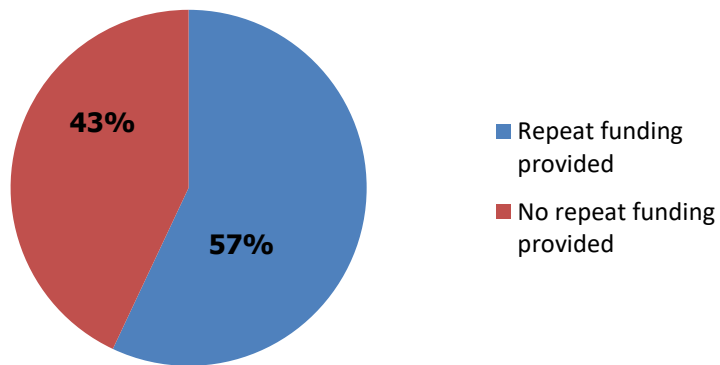

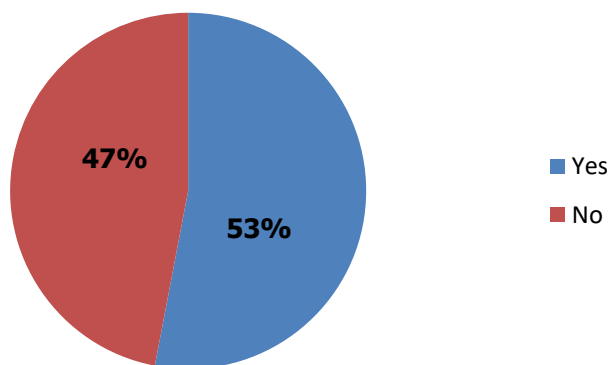

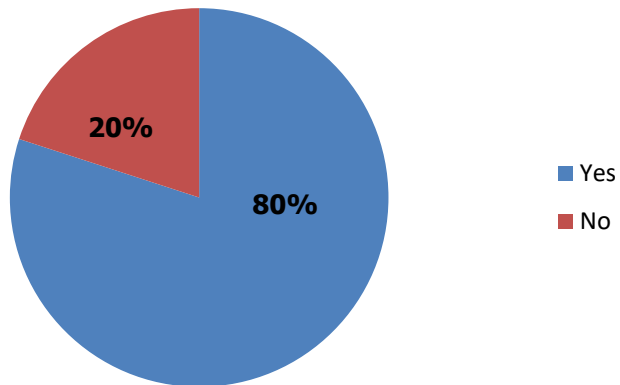

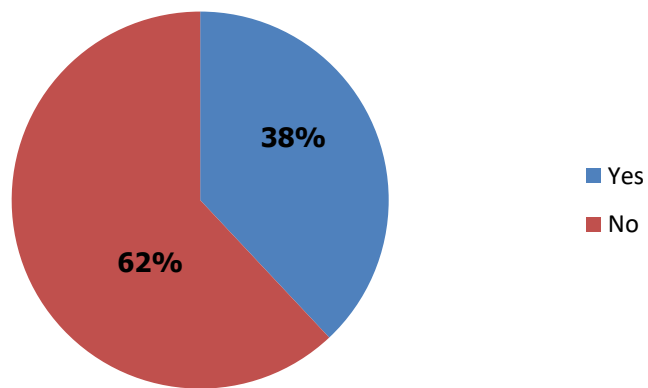

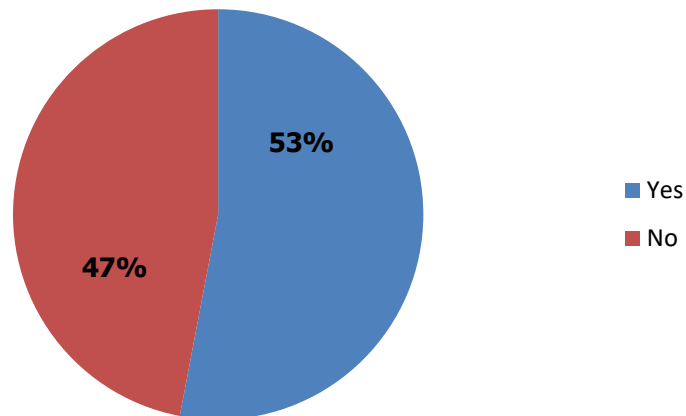

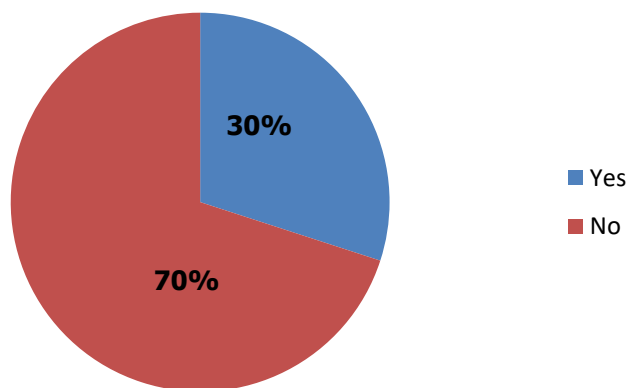

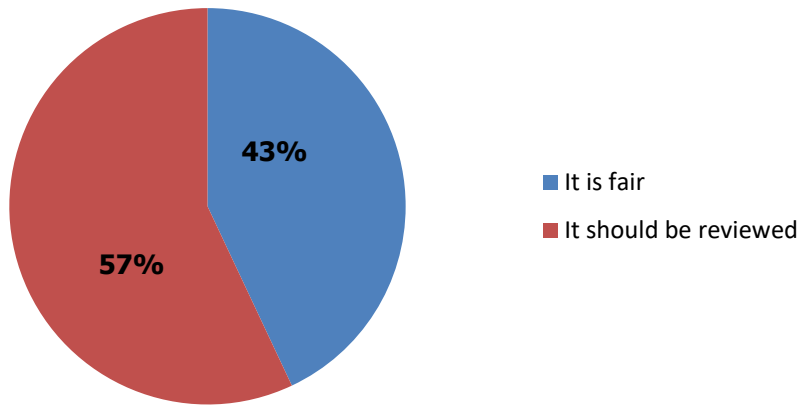
