

## Harvesting Map



Remaining dense stands of partially windblown conifer within the community woodland will be removed to enable early re-establishment of more diverse species and increased 'naturalness' of this important recreational hub.

Felling prioritised where management will support activities to enhance conservation value and protect designated watercourses.

Deadwood and future veterans will be recruited in NR areas.

Mixed conifer natural regen will be managed as a nurse species to support MB establishment and gradually removed.


