

Future veterans and areas of standing deadwood will be recruited within areas managed as LISS.

Windblown plantations will be felled and landscape impact mitigated through use of LISS. Shelterwood system will be employed to remove diseased trees and recruit native broadleaf and mixed conifer species to maintain a sense of continuous forest cover and recreational access.

The shape, scale and timing of felling has been designed to ensure a more diverse structure that can be maintained as felling takes place and new crops become established in the core recreational hub areas.


The process of restoring areas of greatest ecological potential identified by MWT will be undertaken and managed so as not to the detriment of existing bog habitat values.

Phytophthora infected larch will be prioritised in the first phase within the core recreational hub

Open ground will be maintained alongside wildlife reserves to protect scheduled bird species.
