Interpretation Act 2015

## HARBOUR (FEES) ORDER 2023<sup>1</sup>

Laid before Tynwald:21 March 2023Coming into Operation: in accordance with article 2

The Department of Infrastructure, with the concurrence of the Treasury<sup>1</sup>, makes the following Order<sup>2</sup> under section 81 of the Interpretation Act 2015.

#### 1 Title

This Order is the Harbour (Fees) Order 2023.

#### 2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day after it is made.

#### 3 Harbour Fees

- (1) In respect of each function or service specified in column 2 of the Schedule, the fee specified in column 3 is payable by any person benefiting from the function or using the service, as the case may be.
- (2) Paragraph (1) is subject to article 4.

#### 4 Exemption

- (1) Article 3 does not apply to officers of the Customs and Excise Division of the Treasury.
- (2) For the purpose of this article, "officer" has the same meaning as section 184 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1986.

#### 5 Revocation

The Harbour (Fees) Order 2022<sup>3</sup> is revoked.
