HARBOUR (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) BYE-LAWS 2017¹

*Approved by Tynwald:**16 May 2017**Coming into Operation:**1 June 2017*

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Bye-laws under sections 4 and 82, and paragraphs 1, 3 and 14 of Schedule 1 to the Harbours Act 2010.

1 Title

These Byelaws are the Harbour (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bye-laws 2017.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Byelaws come into operation on 1 June 2017.

3 Licence fees

- (1) The Schedule has effect.
- (2) The Schedule applies fees in respect of licences issued by the Department of Infrastructure in accordance with the Bye-laws made by the Isle of Man Harbours Commissioners on the 9th May 1905, and confirmed by Tynwald on the 5th July 1905.
- (3) Any fees payable are calculated in accordance with the Schedule.

4 Exemptions

Bye-law 3 does not apply to officers of the Customs and Excise Division of the Treasury.

5 Harbour (Pleasure Craft Insurance) Bye-laws 2017 amended
